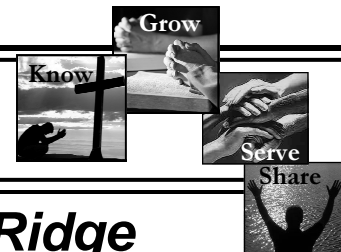

What I See Happening at Pea Ridge

“To Know Christ and Make Him Known!”

I am so excited about what God is doing at PRBC. It seems like every time I look around something new is happening or someone new is coming into our fellowship. I see people who are maturing in their faith and in an understanding of what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. I see people stepping out to serve in new ways. I see people who are making commitments to growing and being all that God wants them to be! As your pastor, it is so wonderful to see God at work in the lives of individuals in our church. I can see the Holy Spirit at work in the lives of people each day.

I believe that one of the realities I am seeing is people making right choices and setting right priorities in their lives. The scriptures are full of instruction when it comes to putting God first. The writer of Proverbs said, *“Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight”* (Proverbs 3:5-6, NIV). When we trust in the faithfulness and goodness of the Lord, we are promised that we will be directed in the ways of God. Jesus told his followers to *“Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.”* (Matthew 6:33, NLT). When one makes the right choices and puts God first, I know God blesses that decision and will respond with provision and wisdom in our daily lives.

I also see people seeking purpose in their lives. As Christians, we must identify what purpose we are living for in our lives. As a church, we participated in the 40 Days of Purpose campaign in the fall of 2003. This was a great time for our church and for individuals to answer the question “What on earth

am I here for?” The opening statement of the book The Purpose Driven Life, by Rick Warren, is “It’s not about you.”

This sets the tone for the book and the study of purpose of our lives. Searching and understanding purpose will never be fulfilled if we only focus on ourselves. Warren continues,

“...you cannot arrive at our life’s purpose by starting with a focus on yourself. You must begin with God, your Creator. You exist only because God wills that you exist. You were made by God and for God – and until you understand that, life will never make sense. It is only in God that we discover our origin, our identity, our meaning, our purpose, our significance, and our destiny. Every other path leads to a dead end“(Rick Warren, The Purpose Driven Life, p. 18).

I see people searching for purpose and meaning in their lives and I see them finding that in a relationship with God. That is most important for us all to understand and live out.

I must be the first to say that over the past few months I have struggled with both of these realities in my own life. I have trusted in myself too often and have failed many times. I have searched for meaning and purpose on my own with only me in mind...only to find a dead end and frustration in my days. What I am finding is so simple...focus on my relationship with God...the BIG THING...and then the other parts of my life, relationships, leadership, parenting and more will fall into place.

Such a simple lesson in life, but one that will transform your heart and your life toward God’s purpose and will. It is not easy to live in this way, but it is possible and will make you a purpose filled person God can use. My prayer is that we will continue to put God first in our individual lives and in our church!

Throughout the Easter season a sacrificial offering was collected to pay off the church mortgage. We owed just under \$20,000. Donations came in and we paid the balance down to \$4,600.00. Then the Church Council decided to go ahead and pay the balance from our Reserved funds, money set aside from the end of last year for emergencies. This money has been replenished monthly from the mortgage budget line. Additional donations have been used to replenish our Reserved Fund. We are so thankful for the response.

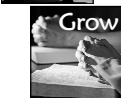

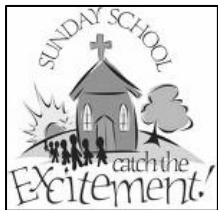

You're Invited to Sunday School



Are you attending a morning worship service, and would like an opportunity to learn with a small group of people as well? Why not join us for Sunday School at 10:10 am? Get started today by attending one of the groups below.

 The folks in **The Homebuilders Class** range from 50 to 90+ years old. Led by Emerson Davis and David Groves, the class uses the Life way quarterly in their study of the Bible. During the summer quarter they will study The New Testament Church using First and Second Corinthians. The Homebuilders meet in the back hallway in the basement of the church. Many of the members of this class are actively involved in the Golden Group, which meets at noon on the third Tuesday in the Fellowship Hall for a lunch/program.

 Go to the Fellowship Hall, grab a warm muffin, fill your cup with hot coffee, and join our nontraditional class, known as **Shalom** (in a classroom partitioned off of the main room). Led by Louie and Johnna Gaunch, this class uses a video-based curriculum. Adults of all ages and all stages are welcome. Beginning June 6-July 4 the class will tackle the confusing issue and often misunderstood topic of judging others. The title of the series is "Judgment Call" by Andy Stanley.

 Currently using the MasterWorks curriculum from Life way, the **SonSeekers** welcome adults of any age and in any phase of their lives. A discussion oriented class, led by Ron Brownfield, meets in the library off of the Fellowship Hall. The summer curriculum is entitled "Landmines in the Path of the Believer" by Charles Stanley and "Fire and Rain: The Wild-Hearted Faith of Elijah" by Ray Pritchard.

 The **Covenant Keepers**, led by Mark Booth, will meet in the Fellowship Hall this summer. Although this class is primarily married couples, they certainly are not exclusive. Other commonalities, like parenting teenagers, appreciating an empty nest, or balancing your life may make this the group you need.

 Women of all ages and stages are invited to attend the **Women of Faith** class. Led by Tricia Leonard, the ladies delve into God's Word through various teaching DVDs and discussion. This class offers an opportunity for women to share and build relationships with other women. They meet in a classroom partitioned from the Fellowship Hall.

Students entering sixth grade through high school will meet in the Youth Room as a large group for the summer. The lessons, taught by a variety of guest speakers, will be used as a springboard for Sunday night and Wednesday night activities.

Promotion Sunday -Students, finishing fifth grade and younger will promote to the next Sunday school class. As children move from one department to another or level to another they are gifted with a Bible. We are blessed at PRBC with many children and this area is growing as we reach out to our surrounding communities. Praise God! MORE GOOD YOUTH STUFF

We will be going to King's Island Thursday, June 10. Details will be shared through Youth Meetings.

We had seven students and four adults participate in OMEGA. These individuals also participated in a 30-hour famine to bring awareness to world hunger. There were a few others who were unable to go to OMEGA, but still did the fasting. As a group we raised \$829.00 (fantastic!) that will go to World Vision toward fighting hunger and poverty.

Through this we also chose to support a World Vision child on a monthly basis. Our child is Himel, a 13-year old boy who lives in Bangladesh. If each student brings in just one dollar a month, we will be able to meet our \$35 per month commitment. A small sacrifice that will have huge, everlasting impact on the life of one of God's own.

Nursery, Toddler & Preschool Sunday Schedule

During these early years we have a special opportunity to instill in our children a love of church and God. This is not just a time of babysitting, it is a time of learning about sharing, singing, playing and enjoying their time in God's house. Also, as we provide childcare for these small children, we are providing a parent (sometimes both parents) with a chance to learn more about God and to grow in their faith.

Occasionally we can combine these three age groups when the classes were small, but the wide age ranges can make this unsafe and our numbers are growing! So we are begging for help. It takes a lot of loving hands to provide these three classes at every service and we are desperate.

We have completed another fun and exciting school year...time for some much needed R & R!

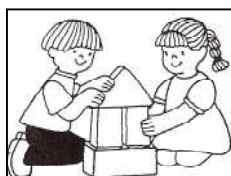
We are looking forward to next year. Registrations have been going very well and many of our classes are already full. We do have a waiting list and many of those will get to attend our Preschool.

Giving and Sharing With Others

Luke 3:7-11 "John [the Baptist] said to the crowds...Produce fruit in keeping with repentance. And do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' God can raise up children for Abraham. The ax is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire."

"What should we do then?" the crowd asked.

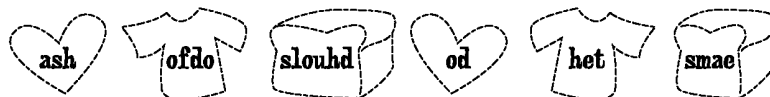
